



Student Retention Rates for inlingua Intensive English Programs (GPIP and TL2)

The values presented below represent the percentage of students enrolled in each program (GPIP and TL2) and location who started *and* completed the most recent academic term for which data is available (the Autumn 2011 Quarter). However, students enrolled in TL2 English programs who successfully completed their enrollment before the end of the term are counted as completers. Raw numbers for program completers versus starters are provided in parentheses.

Notes:

1. The most common reasons for attrition are expulsion from the program (and termination of the student's SEVIS record for F-1 visa students) for failure to meet the program's attendance requirements, voluntary withdrawal for personal or medical reasons, and transfer to another institution.
2. Retention tends to correlate inversely with length of enrollment. Consequently, since the average length of enrollment for GPIP students is greater than for TL2 students, retention rates for students enrolled in TL2 English programs are somewhat higher (on average) than for students enrolled in the GPIP.
